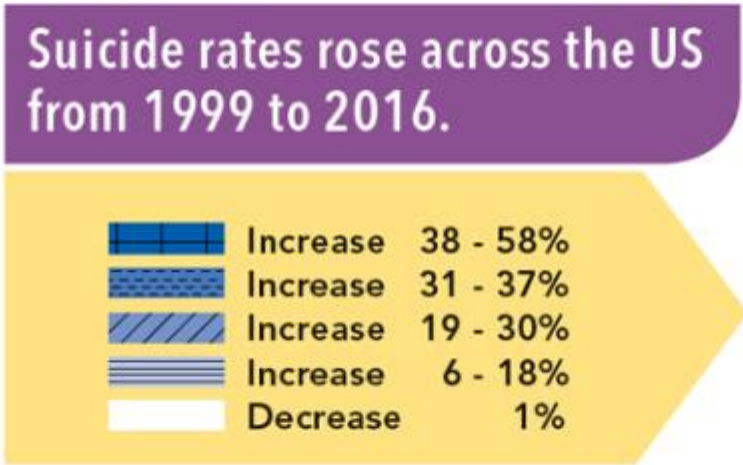




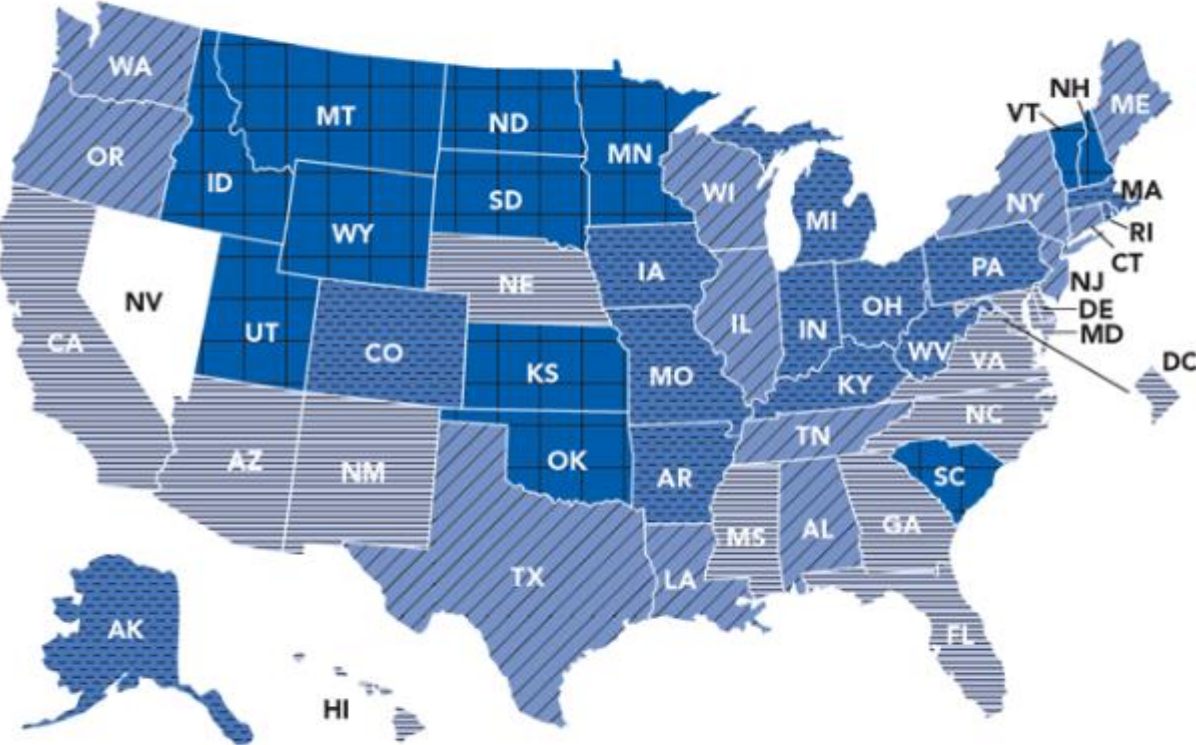

More than a mental health concern

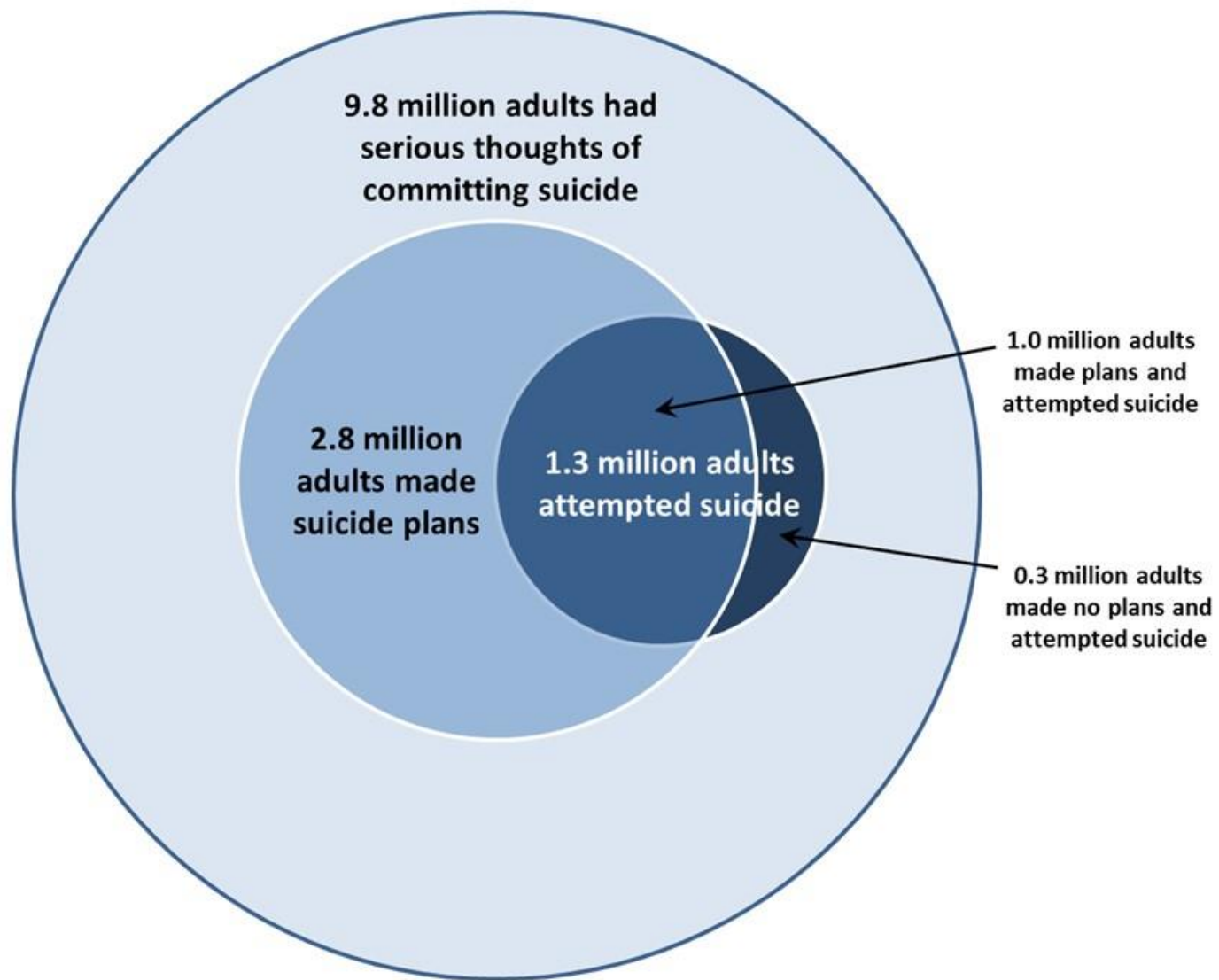

Past Year Suicidal Thoughts and Behavior Among U.S. Adults (2017) - SAMHSA

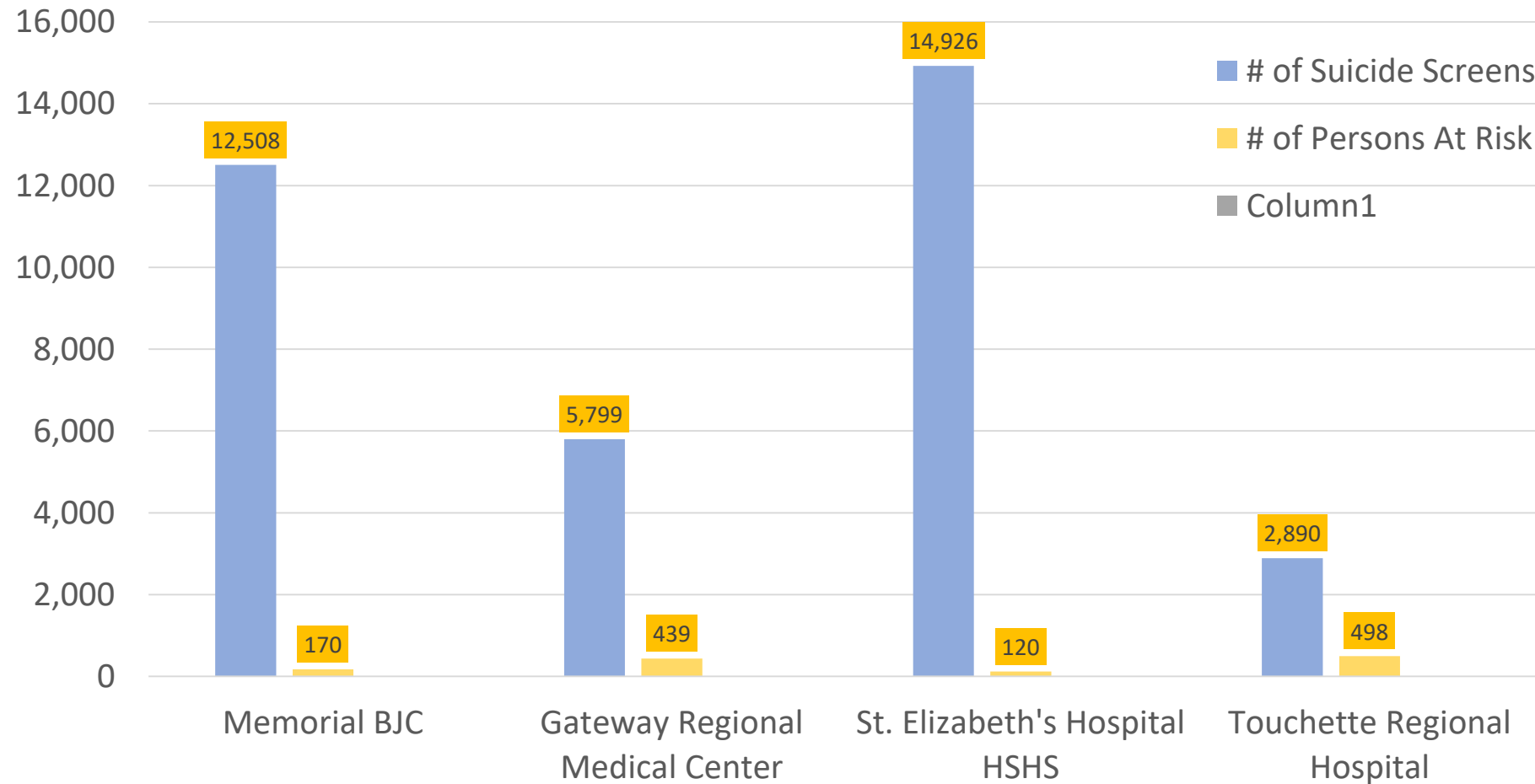


So Why Is This Important to You?

- Depression affects an estimated 12% of male doctors, up to 19.5% of female doctors, and even more common in medical students and residents
- One doctor dies by suicide in the U.S. every day
- Doctors' suicide rate is highest of Any Profession
- Female doctors attempt suicide far less often than women in the general population; the completion rate exceeds the general population by 2.5 to 4 times.
- Completion rate for female doctors = the completion rate of male doctors.
- Female Suicide rates were significantly higher ranking Registered nurses (Healthcare Practitioners and Technical major group) as the fifth highest.

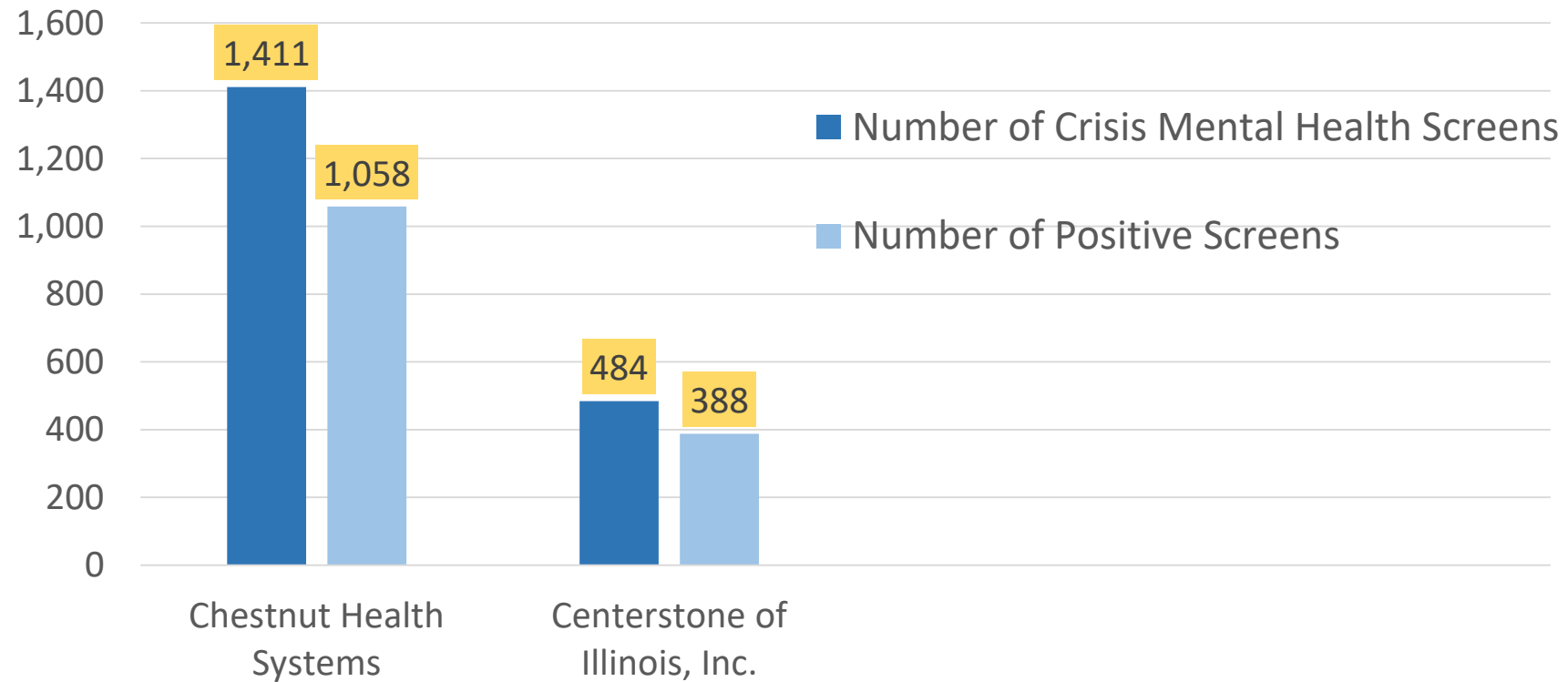
Local Hospital Suicide Risk Screening

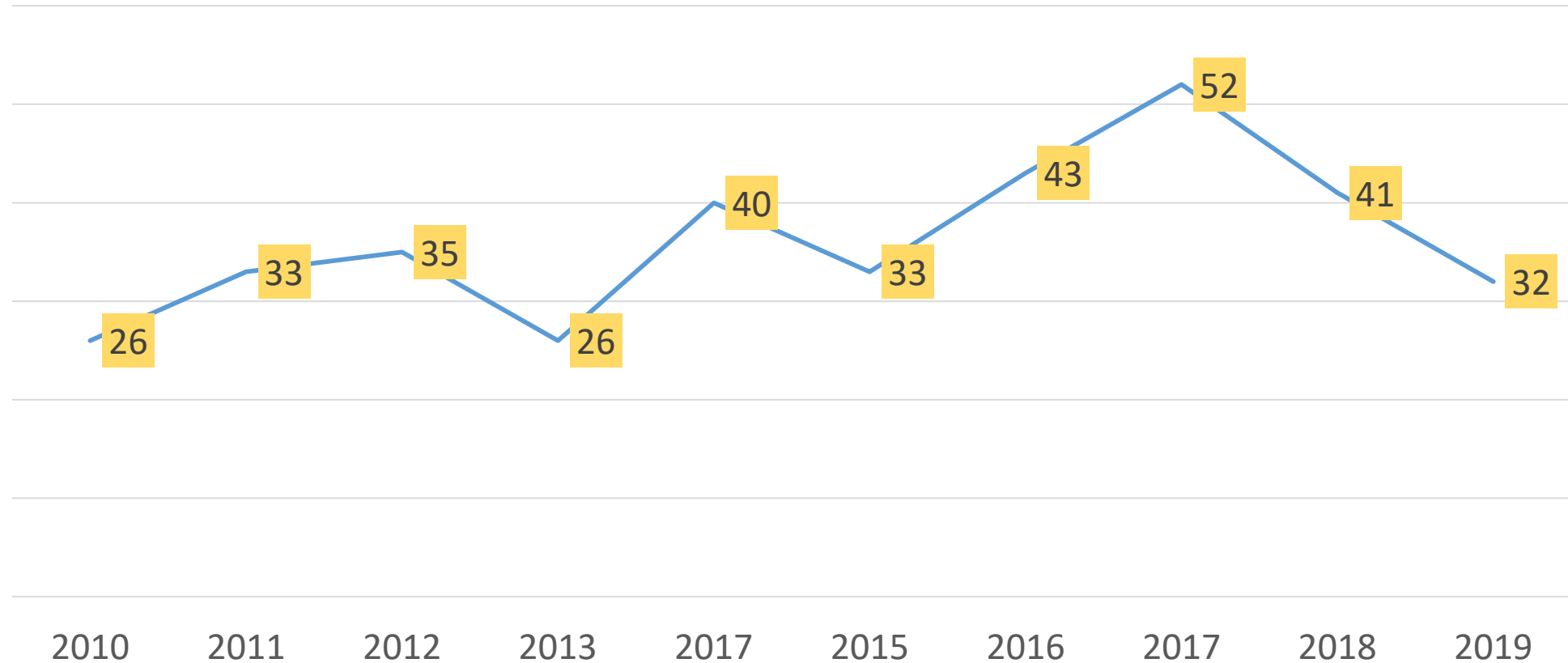

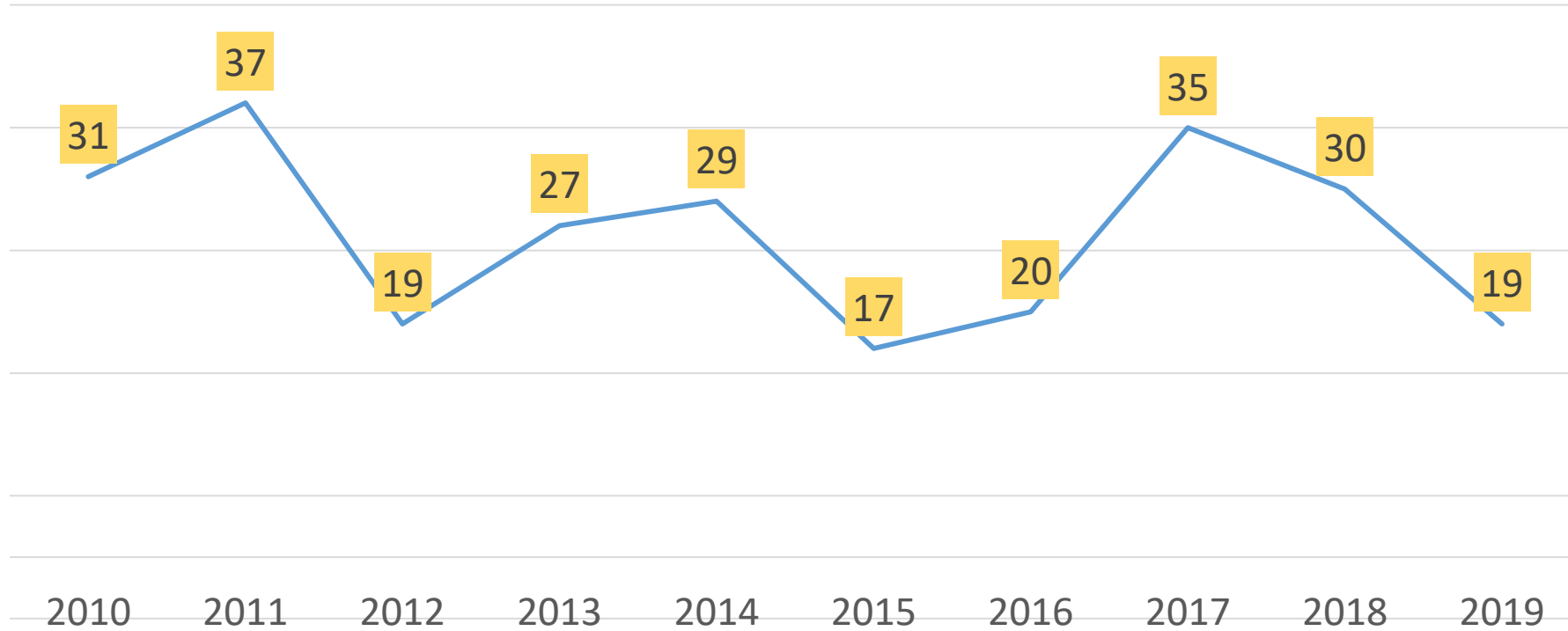

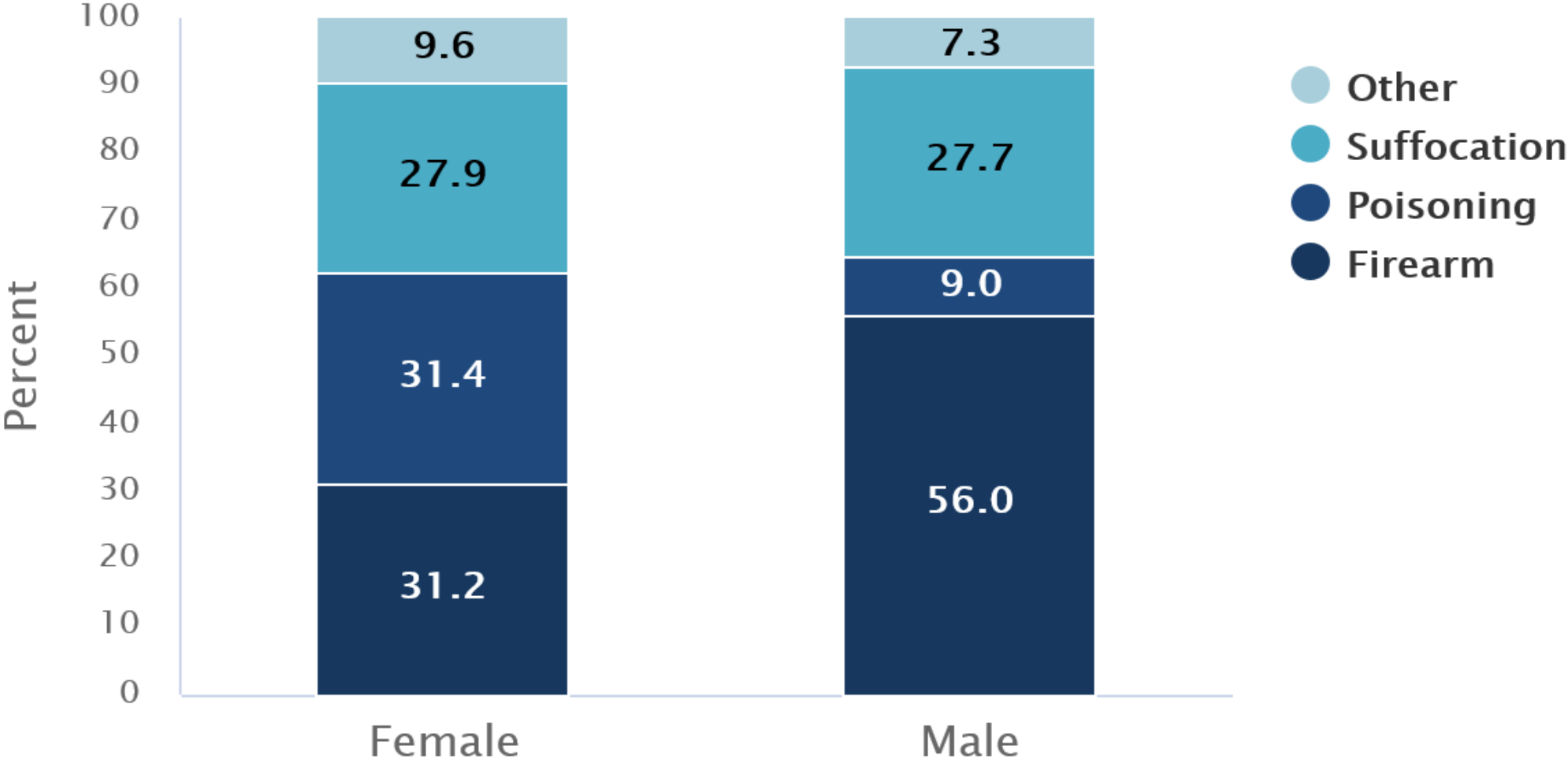
