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## **Early Childhood Program Enrollment Checklist**

These documents are needed to complete your registration/enrollment.



#### **Valid Photo ID for Parent/Legal Guardian**

A valid Photo Identification Card of the parent or guardian enrolling the child in school. Examples: Driver's License, State, Military, High School/College I.D., or U.S. Passport.



#### **Child's Birth Certificate**

If your child was born in St. Clair County, you can obtain a copy of the birth certificate at <a href="https://countyclerk.co.st-clair.il.us/records/Pages/default.aspx">https://countyclerk.co.st-clair.il.us/records/Pages/default.aspx</a> or by going in person, but call before you go to verify service hours. Fees for certificates start at \$15. Scholarships may be available, ask the programs below for more information.



#### Child's Up-To-Date Physical Exam & Immunization Record

Your child's doctor should complete the Illinois Health Examination Form which includes: a current list of Immunizations, an Allergy/Asthma Action Plan, proof of Lead & TB Screenings, any medical diagnosis of a disability that your child may have, and Medical Authorization Form. If you don't have a family doctor, clinics in the area may provide this service.



#### **Child's Most Recent Dental Exam**

A copy of your child's most recent Dental Exam Records are needed. If you do not have them, your child may be able to have a dental exam completed during the Enrollment process.



#### (2) Proofs of East St. Louis Residency (East St. Louis School District 189 Only)

Two of the following documents are needed for your child's school records: Apartment/House Lease Agreement, Mortgage Document/Property Deed, Valid Driver's License, State Medical Card, Utility Bill (Gas, Water, Electric).



#### (1) Income Verification

To verify your household income one of the following documents are needed: SSI, WIC, SNAP, or TANF Statement, 2019 W2 Form(s), 2019 Completed 1040 Tax Form(s), Child Support Statement, 2 most recent Paycheck Stubs.
